Class	Categories	Entered
Categories 1-6 must have been grown by the entrant (plate can be paper, it is not judged in the competition)		
1	3 tomatoes on a plate	
2	3 onions on a plate	
3	3 potatoes on a plate	
4	A plate of any 3 vegetables (one of each)	
5	Bowl of mixed salad leaves	
6	Single flower stem (any variety) in a jar	
7	Flower arrangement in an unusual container, using home grown OR shop bought flowers	
8	A seed head character - i.e cress, grass in fact anything! Make the face as fun as possible	
9	A vegetable character - carve or dress up any vegetable to make a character - maybe a super hero, a clown, or even someone you know!	
10	A homemade bowl of soup, including the recipe, to include at least 2 vegetables	
11	An interesting salad, including the recipe, using home grown or shop bought ingredients	
12	A fruit based refreshment with the recipe - this could be a cake, fruit salad, juice - the choice is yours	
13	A photograph entitled 'Nature at it's Best' (could be plants, animals, a garden, a view, the sea etc.)	
14	A planted container, to include edible plants, eg herbs, vegetables etc	
15	A poem or limerick about gardening	
16	A picture of wildlife in the garden - this could be a drawing, a painting, a photograph or even a word picture (eg a piece of creative writing)	
17	A decorated sun hat entitled 'I'll eat my hat'	
The following must be created by more than one generation, eg. Child and grandparent, although does not have to be a family member, can be a friend of a different generation (please specify who has made the entry)		
18	A container planted with flowering plants	
19	A piece of art of craft entitled 'An English Summer' (could be a model, a card, a poster, a poem, a collage, needlecraft, woodwork, pressed flowers, jewellery... anything you can imagine!)	
20	A decorated cake entitled 'The Edible Garden' - this could be a large cake or a plate of no more than 6 small cakes (the cake does not need to be home made - just home decorated)
